In the Circuit Court of said County:

The grand jurors in and for the body of said County of Rockingham and now attending said Court at its October term, 1922, upon their oaths, do present that Tate Rhodes and E. E. Cordell within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment, in the said County of Rockingham, did unlawfully manufacture, sell, offer, keep, store and expose for sale, give away, transport, dispense, solicit, advertise and receive orders for ardent spirits, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

And the grand jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid, do further present that Tate Rhodes and E. E. Cordell within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment in said County of Rockingham did unlawfully get drunk in a public place, to-wit, on the Valley Turnpike, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of W. P. Wine, S. F. Newman, and E. J. Dillard, witnesses sworn in court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.

We the jury find the defendant, Fate Rhodes guilty of transporting ardent spirits unlawfully, as charged in this indictment and for his punishment at one month's confinement in jail and a fine of \$53.00 and we find E. E. Cordell guilty of being drunk in a public place as charged in the indictment and for his punishment at a fine of ten dollars.
