To The Sheriff of Rockingham County:-

WHEREAS D. E. Croushorn and J. R. Logan, of the said City, have this day made complaint and information on oath before me, T. A. Willis, a Justice of the Peace of the said City, that Charles Winston, of the said City, on the 25th day of June, 1916, in the said City, did unlawfully sell one pint of Belle of Jefferson whiskey to one John Hawse on Sunday, the said one pint of Belle of Jefferson whiskey being ardent spirits.

These are, therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me the body of the said Charles Winston to answer the said complaint and to be further dealt with according to law.

And you are moreover required to summon John Hawse and John Harper to appear at the time and place of trial to give evidence on behalf of the Commonwealth on the examination touching the said offense.
