

THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE 18th day of March in the year of our Lord 1833 Between *M. H.*

Harris one of the Overseer of the Poor of the District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *Henry Miller* of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the 18th day of March in the year 1833 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Edward Croft* of the age of 14 ^{years} ~~years~~ to be an Apprentice with him the said *Henry Miller* and as an Apprentice with him the said *Henry Miller* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Edward Croft* shall arrive, and come to the age of 21 years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said *Edward Croft* shall the said *Henry Miller* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Edward Croft* shall be put unto by his said *Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Edward Croft* and the said *Edward Croft* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *Henry Miller* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Henry Miller* And the said *Henry Miller* for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *Blacksmithing* which he the said *Henry Miller* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *Henry Miller* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the the term aforesaid: And also that the said *Henry Miller* shall teach, or cause to be taught to the *Edward Croft* Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three and will moreover pay to the said *Edward Croft* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
