of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of

an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date the

July

last Court

in the year 1844 has

placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind

Mary Montgomery

of the age of Twelve

years to be an Apprentice with him the said

Isaac H. Abbott

and as an Apprentice

with him the said Isaac H. Abbott

to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said

Mary Montgomery

shall arrive, and come to the age of Eighteen years, according

to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said

Mary Montgomery shall the said Isaac H. Abbott

well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Mary Montgomery shall be put unto

by the said Master

according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said Mary Montgomery and

she the said Mary Montgomery

honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said Isaac

H. Abbott

and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said Isaac H. Abbott

And the said Isaac H. Abbott

for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby

promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said

Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of Basket making

which he the said

Isaac H. Abbott

now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform,

or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said

Isaac H. Abbott

shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel,

washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

Isaac H. Abbott

shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said Mary Montgomery

Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Mary

Montgomery

the Sum of Twenty

Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
