Gentlemen:

We are now preparing a list of names, together with the addresses, of those persons to whom a copy of the Daily News-Record shall be sent as directed by the Court's order entered on August 2 in reference to the National Park.

Will you be so kind as to give us the following information? First: Is a copy of the newspaper to be mailed to only such persons as are named in Table V (beginning with page 103)? Second: In Table V there are those who are referred to as "footnote a," which is found on page 99½ and which says "value of this tract un-ascertained," the same being referred to in Exception No. I. (The numbers included in Exception No. 1 do not seem to include all those marked "see footnote a"). Third: In other words, please tell me definitely as nearly as you can where in the report I can find the definite information as to whom the notice shall be sent.
