This Indenture made this seventunth day of May in The year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen between Aaron Tolomon one of the Overseers of the loor for The West district in the County of Rocking ham of the one part, and Valentine Miller of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth Shat the said Oversur of the Poor in pursus and to an order of the Court of the County aforesaid being on the abovedate doth put and bind Nicholas a free boy of Coulbur (supposed to be seventeen years of sige at this time) as an Apprentice to the said Valentine Miller, with him often the manner of an apprentice to dwell and serve un till he shall arrive to the age of twenty one years, to learn the Ant Frade and mystery of a Black smith. In consideration of which the said Miller binds himself to the said Tolomon or his Juccesson Overseir of the Portoteachon instruction ause to be taught or instructed, the said Nicholas the Ant & Mystery of a blacksmith during said term. And more over to find the said Nicholas in good & sufficient Clouthing Meat Drink Washing, and Lodging fit and Sond also at the end of his Service shall pay and satisfy to the said Nicholas twenty Dollars, that being the freedom dues allowed by the court.
