

THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE *Twenty Seventh* day of *March*
in the year of our Lord 18*45* Between *Jacob Hornsberger* Overseer of the Poor of the
first District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *Jacob Wynant*
of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid
bearing date the *first* day of *December* in the year *One Thousand Eight hundred & Twenty four*
has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Maryann Staten* of the age
of *Five years the 20th of next February* years, to be an Apprentice with him the said *Jacob Wynant*
and as an Apprentice with him the said *Jacob Wynant* to dwell from the date of these presents,
until the said *Maryann Staten* shall arrive and come to the age of *Eighteen*
years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said
Maryann Staten shall the said *Jacob Wynant* ~~her~~ said
Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Maryann Staten*
shall be put unto by *Said Jacob Wynant* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of *her the said Maryann Staten*
the said *Maryann Staten* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards
him the said *Jacob Wynant* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family
of the said *Jacob Wynant* And the said *Jacob Wynant*
for himself Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his
Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a *house keeping*
which he the said *Jacob Wynant* now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,
instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that
he the said Jacob Wynant shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient
meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that
the said *Jacob Wynant* shall teach or cause to be taught to the said *Maryann Staten*
Reading, Writing, and ~~Common Arithmetic~~ *including the Single Rule of Three*, and will moreover pay to the said *Maryann*
Staten the Sum of *Fifteen* Dollars at the Expiration of the
aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year
above written.
