The jurors aforesaid upon their oaths aforesaid do further present that Alonzo Hensley within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment in the said County of Rockingham did unlawfully have in his possession a still, still cap, worm, tub, fermenter, and other appliances connected with and used in the operation of a still, without having the same registered as required by law, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of W. E. Lucas, a witness sworn in court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.




