

THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE 21th day of August

in the year of our Lord 1832 Between John F. Effinger

one of the Overseer of the Poor of the *Harrisonburg* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *Henry Tutwiler* of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid baring date the 20th day of August

in the year 1832 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Elizabeth Payne* of the age of Twelve years & 6 months, to be an Apprentice with him the said *Henry Tutwiler* and as an Apprentice with him the said *Henry Tutwiler* to dwell from the

date of these presents, until the said *Elizabeth Payne* shall arrive, and come to the age of Eighteen years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided For and during all which time and term the said *Elizabeth Payne* shall the said *Henry Tutwiler*

well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Elizabeth Payne* shall be put unto by his said *Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Elizabeth Payne* and the said *Elizabeth Payne* honestly and obediently in all things be-

have towards the said *Henry Tutwiler* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Henry Tutwiler* And the said *Henry Tutwiler* for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the

Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *house Business* which he the said *Tutwiler* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and

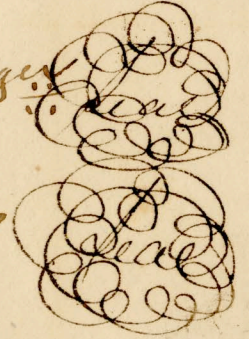
informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *Henry Tutwiler* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

H Tutwiler shall teach, or cause to be taught to the *Elizabeth Payne* Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Elizabeth Payne* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
