

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE 25th day of December

in the year of our Lord 1823 Between Philip Kootz Overseer of the Poor of the

District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Abraham Phillips

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid
bearing date the 3rd day of November in the year 1823

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind John Jewel of the age
of 17 years years, to be an Apprentice with him the said Phillips

and as an Apprentice with him the said Abraham Phillips to dwell from the date of these presents,
until the said John Jewel shall arrive and come to the age of Twentyone

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said
John Jewel shall the said Abraham Phillips his said

Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said John Jewel
shall be put unto by his said Master according to the Power, Wit and Ability of him

the said John Jewel honestly and obediently in all things behave towards
his said Master and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family

of the said Abraham Phillips And the said Abraham Phillips
for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his

Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a Farmer
which he the said Phillips now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that
he the said Abraham Phillips shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that
the said Phillips shall teach or cause to be taught to the said John Jewel

Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said
John Jewel the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the

aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangeably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year
above written.
