Yancey; and the Clerk of this Court is directed to transmit a certified copy of this order to the Treasurer of Virginia, who shall pay unto the said Thomas L. Yancey the said sum of \$2,180.00, the amount of the award set out in the julgment of condemnation for Tract No. 213-a, taking from the said Thomas L. Yancey a receipt therefor and certifying such payment to the Clerk of this Court for appropriate entry thereof as required by law.
