

This Indenture made this 24th Day of ^{September} in the Year of our Lord
One Thousand Seven Hundred & ninety Eight & in the twenty third year
of the Independance of the United States of America between John Graham
Overseer of the poor in the County of Rockingham of the one part
and Abraham Miller of the other part Witnesseth that the said
John Graham Overseer of the poor as aforesaid by virtue of an Order
of the Court of the aforesaid County bearing Date July 20th 1798 Have
put placed & Bound by these presents do put place & Bind Jacob
Bergerhiser a poor Boy whose Parents Jacob Bergerhiser & Barbara Ber-
gerhiser are so poor they cannot support him of the Age of four Year the 20 Day of
February last past to be an Apprentice with him the said Abraham
Miller to dwell from the Date of these presents until the said Jacob
Bergerhiser shall come to the Age of 21 Years according to the
Act of the General Assembly in that Case made & provided By and
During all which Time & Term the said Jacob Bergerhiser shall
the said Abraham Miller his said Master well & faithfully serve
in all such lawful Business as the said Jacob Bergerhiser shall
be put unto by his said Master according to the Power wit &
Ability of him the said Jacob Bergerhiser & honestly & obediently in
all things shall behave himself towards his said Master and Ho-
nestly & Orderly towards the rest of the family of the said Abraham
Miller. And the said Abraham Miller for his part for himself his
Executors & Administrators doth hereby promise & covenant to & with
the said Overseer of the poor & every of them their & every of their Ex-
ecutors & Administrators & their & every of their Successors for the
Time being & to & with the said Jacob Bergerhiser that he the said Abra-
ham Miller shall the said Jacob Bergerhiser in the Craft Mystery &
Occupation of a Sadler which he the said Abraham Miller now useth
after the Best Manner he can & may teach instruct & inform or cause
to be taught instructed & informed as much as thereunto belongeth
or in any wise appertaineth. And that the said Abraham Miller shall
also find and Allow unto the said Apprentice, Meet. Suit. Apparel.
Washing Lodging & all other things needful or Meet for an Apprentice
During said Term And also that the said Abraham Miller shall teach
or cause to be taught to the said Jacob Bergerhiser Reading Writing
& Common Arithmetick including the Rule of Three! and will more-
over pay unto the said Jacob Bergerhiser the sum of Twelve
Dollars at the Expiration of his aforesaid Term. In Witness
