

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE *24th* day of *June* in the year of our Lord 1826 Between *Samuel Coote* Overseer of the Poor of the District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *Abraham Peery (son of John)* of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid baring date the *March* day of *1826* in the year has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Charles Brown* *Six Years* of ~~the~~ age ~~at the 7th day of November 1825~~, to be an Apprentice with him the said *Abraham Peery* and as an Apprentice with him the said *Abraham Peery* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Charles Brown* shall arrive and come to the age of *Twenty one* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said *Charles Brown* shall the said *Abraham Peery* his said *Master* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Charles Brown* shall be put unto by *his said Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of *him* the said *Charles Brown* and honestly and obediently in all things behave towards *his* said *Master* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of the said *Abraham Peery* And the said *Abraham Peery* for himself *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a *Farmer* which he the said *Abraham Peery* now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach, instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *Abraham Peery* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said *Abraham Peery* shall teach or cause to be taught to the said *Charles Brown* Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Charles Brown* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year above written.
