

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE 5<sup>th</sup> day of July

in the year of our Lord 1822 Between Samuel Bowman an Overseer of the Poor of the Northern District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and John Sigler of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June in the year 1822 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Lydia Kingardner a Poor girl of the age of <sup>18</sup> years old the 18 of May last to be an Apprentice with him the said John Sigler and as an Apprentice with him the said John Sigler to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said Lydia Kingardner shall arrive and come to the age of Eighteen years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said Lydia Kingardner shall the said John Sigler her ~~his~~ said Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Lydia Kingardner shall be put unto by the said John Sigler according to the Power, Wit and Ability of her the said Lydia Kingardner and shall honestly and obediently in all things behave towards him the said John Sigler and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of the said John Sigler And the said John Sigler for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a Semster which he the said John Sigler now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach, instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said John Sigler shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said Lydia Kingardner shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Lydia Kingardner Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic <sup>Exclusive of</sup> the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Lydia Kingardner the Sum of twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangeably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year above written.
