

This Indenture MADE THE 15th day of November

in the year of our Lord 1842 Between *Jacob Rohr Sr.*

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the *first* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and *David Rusmisse* of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date the *August Court* ~~day of~~ *1842* in the year 1842 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Granvell Kenney* a *free boy of colour* of the age of *between* *10 & 11* years to be an Apprentice with him the said *David Rusmisse* and as an Apprentice with him the said *David Rusmisse* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Granvell Kenney* shall arrive, and come to the age of *Twenty one* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said *Granvell Kenney* shall the said *David Rusmisse* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Granvell Kenney* shall be put unto by his said *Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Granvell Kenney*, and the said *Granvell Kenney* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *David Rusmisse* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *David Rusmisse*. And the said *David Rusmisse* for himself *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *a Tanner* which he the said *David Rusmisse* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said *David Rusmisse* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: ~~As aforesaid~~

~~shall teach, or cause to be taught to the~~
~~Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic~~ including the ~~use~~ of ~~Tools~~ and will moreover pay to the said *Granvell Kenney* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
