

This Indenture Witnesseth that I James Quinn one of the
Overseers of the poor for the County of Rockingham a Greable of an
Order of Court to me directed, July Court 1795 doth by these presents
put and bind Bethewel Williams a base born Child who was formerly bound
to Robert Samples, to Archibald Rutherford, for the term of five Years to
Learn the art and trade of a Gun Smith, to serve him as an Apprentice in the
Said County & State of Virginia, which time the S^d Apprentice his said Master
shall faithfully serve, his secrets keep, his Lawfull Commands everywhere Obey,
he shall do no damage to his said Master, nor wilfully suffer it to be done
By Others, he shall neither buy nor sell, Fornication he shall not commit
Matremony he shall not Contract, at Cards dice or any other unlawfull Game
he shall not play, with his masters Goods or the goods of Others whereby
his said, may Receive Damage, he shall neither haunt Taverns or ^{meeting} ~~all~~
or play houses, but in all things behave himself as a good and faithfull
Servant or Apprentice Ought to do — In Consideration whereof the
Said Master shall provide Sufficient meat Washing & Lodging for
Such an Apprentice, during the said term to Learn him to Read and
Write & Cypher through the Rule of Three, and at the Expiration of
Term Pay or Cause to be paid the ~~freedom~~ ^{sum} ~~one~~ ^{one} Customary or as
the Law Directs, In Witness whereof we do bind ourselves to each
Other Intrechangeably by these presents sealed with our seals and
Dated this 25th Day of October 1795
