


This Indenture Witnesseth that
James Kyle one of the overseers of the poor
for the County of Cockingham agreeably
to order of Court for said County held
at December term in the year four Lord Eight
two hundred and two hath by these pre-
sents bound Samuel Bridwell poor child
of John Bridwell to ~~the~~ Jesse Bowlin
of the County aforesaid to learn the trade, art,
and business of a Boot and Shoemaker

The s^d Bowlin on his part doth
bind himself to find his s^d apprentice
in meat, drink and apparel requisite and
necessary for such an apprentice and give
him tuition with some tract as far as the
rule of three. And the s^d Bowlin doth further
bind himself to instruct his s^d apprentice
carefully in the business or trade of a Boot
and Shoemaker and pay him fifteen
Dollars for his freedom due when his term
of service expires.

And the s^d apprentice on his part
together with the witness of
the poor aforesaid doth by these

parents bind themselves to the s^d. Bowler
that the s^d. Amell Bridwell shall
serve the s^d. Lejos Bowler truly and
faithfully until he arrives at the age of
twenty one years. In witness whereof
the parties have hereunto set their hands
and seals this 21st apt. 1815.
