

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE *Eighth* day of *January* in the year of our Lord 18*25* Between *Samuel Cooty* Overseer of the Poor of the District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *John Kline* of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid baring date the *August* day of *1824* in the year has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Harrison Beeser* of the age of *nine* ~~years~~ ^{last} *the 6th April* years, to be an Apprentice with him the said *John Kline* and as an Apprentice with him the said *John Kline* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Harrison Beeser* shall arrive and come to the age of *Twenty* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said *Harrison Beeser* shall the said *John Kline* his said *Master* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Harrison Beeser* shall be put unto by *his said Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of *him* the said *Harrison Beeser* and honestly and obediently in all things behave towards *his* said *Master* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of the said *John Kline* And the said *John Kline* ~~for himself~~ for himself *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a *Wheelwright* which he the said *John Kline* now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach, instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *John Kline* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said *John Kline* shall teach or cause to be taught to the said *Harrison Beeser* Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Harrison Beeser* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
