This indictment is found on the testimony of Basil Cooper, Harvy Dove, Minnie Yankey, Mrs. Dare Stultz, and Frank Caplinger, witnesses sworn in Court, and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.

We the jury find the defendant, William Cullers, guilty
as charged in the indictment and pay his punishment at
three months in jail and a fine of \$100⁰⁰ -

Be it remembered that on the 21st day of April, 1928,
William Cullers, Angelina Cullers, and L. E. Cullers
came before me, Harry M. Strickler, Bail Commissioner of the said
County of Rockingham, and severally and respectively acknowledged
themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia, in man-
ner and form following, that is to say: the said William
Cullers in the sum of Five Hundred dollars
and the said Angelina Cullers in the sum of Five Hundred
dollars, and the said L. E. Cullers in the sum of Five
Hundred dollars, good and lawful money of the United
States, to be respectively made and levied of their several goods
chattels, lands and tenements, and they severally waive the bene-
fit of their Homestead Exemption as to this obligation, to the use

of the said County, on the 19th day of April 1928, in the said County, did unlawfully operate a certain automobile on the public highway, while being intoxicated.


These are therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me, or some other Justice of the said County, the body of the said
