A. Brown, Trustee is invested with a superior or better right or claim of title in and to the said Tract of land No. 227 and that the record of this cause does not disclose any denial or dispute by any party or person in interest as to the title to said Tract No. 227 or to the proceeds arising from the condemnation thereof, and is therefore entitled to receive the proceeds arising from the condemnation of said Tract No. 227, and it further appearing to the Court that all taxes due or payable upon said Tract No. 227 have been paid, upon consideration whereof it is considered and ordered by the Court that the sum of \$250.00 paid into Court by petitioner as just compensation for Tract No. 227 be paid out and distributed as follows:
