so made as aforesaid; the said Robert Gray afterwards, to wit, on the said 24th day of September, in the year 1809, aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid, lent and advanced to the said Daniel Ragen the said sum of \$ 300; That in further pursuance of the said corrupt and unlawful agreement, the said Robert Gray afterwards, to wit, on the 24th day of September, in the year 1810, at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid, took, accepted, and received from the said Daniel Ragen the said sum of \$ 36 for the loan of, and giving day of payment for, the said sum of \$ 300, which said sum of \$ 36 so as aforesaid agreed to be given and paid to the said Robert Gray and so as aforesaid by him taken, accepted, and received, incurred the rate of six dollars for the forbearing and giving day of payment of one hundred dollars, for one year: And so, the said attorney for the Commonwealth saith, that the said Robert Gray - on the said 24th day of September, in the year 1810, aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid, did unlawfully and corruptly, by means of the aforesaid corrupt bargain and loan, take, accept, and receive from the said Daniel Ragen for the loan of, and giving day of payment for the said ~~part~~ above mentioned sum of money.
