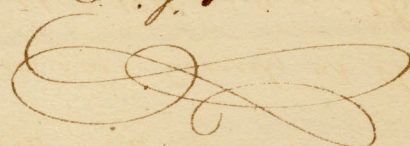


The Commonwealth of Virginia to the Sheriff of Rockingham

do present that ^{alias George Gordon} ~~Chinch Gordon~~ late of the parish of
Rockingham & County of Rockingham Deceased —
on the 17 day of April in the year of our Lord 1811
with force and arms at the parish & County aforesaid and
within the Jurisdiction of the superior Court Holden for the aforesaid
County of Rockingham, in and upon one Andrew Finerty
— in the peace of the Commonwealth then and there
being did make an assault; and him the said Andrew Finerty
— then and there did, beat, bruise, wound, and ill treat
and other injuries to the said Andrew Finerty —
then & there did to the great damage of the said Andrew
Finerty — to the evil example of all others in the like
case offending. and against the peace and dignity of
the Commonwealth of Virginia
