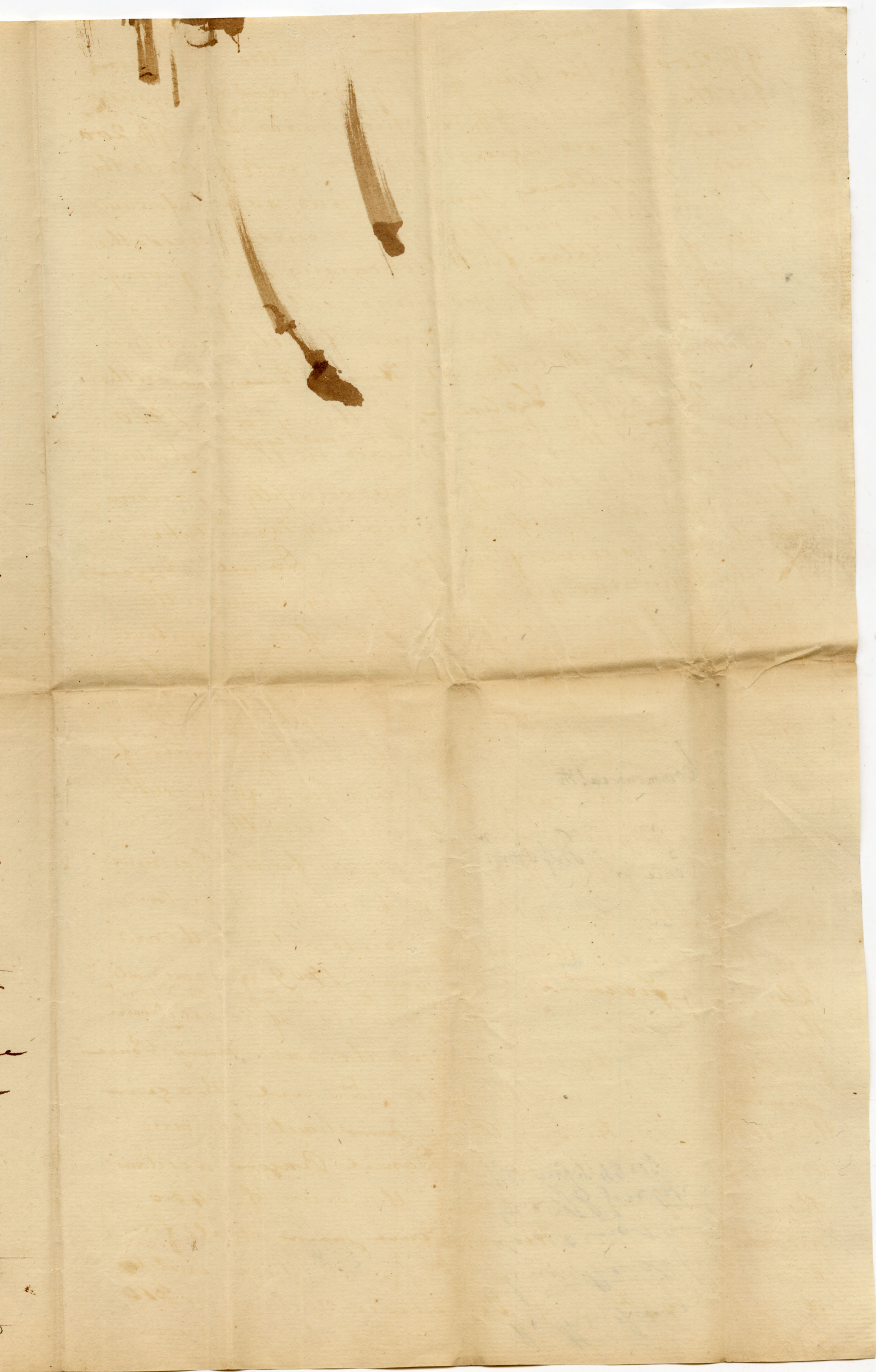


Rockingham County, to wit;

Be it remembered that on the 23^d day of September, in the year 1811 Buscoe & Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth in the Superior Court of said County came into Court and gave the said Court to understand and be informed, that, on the 24th day of September in the year 1809, at the parish of _____ in the County aforesaid, it was corruptly, and against the form of the statute in such case made and provided, agreed by and between Henry Pence, junior, groom, and Daniel Ragen both of the parish and County aforesaid, that the said Henry Pence, junior should lend and advance unto the said Daniel Ragen the sum of \$ 400 of lawful money of Virginia, and that the said Henry Pence junior should forbear and give day of payment thereof to the said Daniel Ragen until and upon the 24th day of September, in the year 1810 then next ensuing and that the said Daniel Ragen for the loan of the said sum of \$ 400 and for giving day of payment thereof as aforesaid, should give and pay to ^{for the time allowed} the said ^{Henry Pence, junior on the said} 24th day of September in the year 1810 aforesaid then next ensuing, the sum of \$ 200 of like lawful money, that in pursuance of the said unlawful and corrupt agreement, so made as aforesaid, the said Henry Pence, junior - afterwards, to wit, on the said 24th day of September in the year 1809 aforesaid at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid, lent and advanced to the said Daniel Ragen the said sum of \$ 400; That in further pursuance of the said corrupt and unlawful agreement, the said Henry Pence, junior afterwards to wit, on the 24th day of September in the year 1810, at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid, took accepted and received from

the said Daniel Rager the said sum
of \$200 for the loan of and giving day of payment
for the said sum of \$400 which said sum of \$200
so as aforesaid agreed to be given and paid to the
said Henry Ponce, junior and so as aforesaid
by him taken, accepted, and received, exceeds the
rate of six dollars for the forbearing and giving
day of payments of one hundred dollars, for one
year: And so the said attorney for the common-
wealth saith, that the said Henry Ponce, junior on the
said 24th day of September, in the year 1860
aforesaid ^{& within the jurisdiction of the said court} at the parish aforesaid in the County
aforesaid, did unlawfully and corruptly by means
of the aforesaid corrupt bargain and loan, take,
accept, and receive from the said Daniel Rager
for the loan and giving day of payment for the
said first above mentioned sum of money above
the rate of six dollars, for one hundred dollars, for
one year against the act of Assembly in such
case made and provided, to the evil example of
all others in such case offending, and against the
peace and dignity, of the Commonwealth.

And the said attorney for the common-
wealth further gives the said Court to understand
and be informed, that afterwards, to wit, on the said
24th day of September in the year 1860 aforesaid, at
the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid ^{& within the jurisdiction of the said court} it was
further agreed by and between the said Henry Ponce
junior — and the said Daniel Rager
that the said Henry Ponce junior should lend and
advance unto the said Daniel Rager a certain
other sum of money, to wit, the sum of \$400
and that the said Henry Ponce junior should for-
bear and give day of payment thereof until
the said 24th day of September in the year 1860
aforesaid; That in pursuance of the said agreement
