Be it remembered, that on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of ~~September~~, in the year 1811, Orisao G. Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth in the Superior Court of said County, came into Court, and gave the said Court to understand and be informed, that heretofore, to wit, on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November, in the year 1809, in the County aforesaid, Conrad Custard, farmer, of the said County, did unlawfully and wilfully erect and build an obstruction, to wit, a fence across the public road leading from Brooks gap in the said County to New Market in the same County, and did then and there unlawfully continue the said obstruction across the said public road in the County aforesaid, from the said 24<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year 1809, for ten months, continually thereafter, to wit, until the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year 1810, contrary to the act of the General Assembly in that case made & provided, and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth.

This information is filed by order of the Court, upon a presentment of the grand jury.
