Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth in the Superior Court of the County aforesaid, came into Court, and gave the said Court to understand & be informed, that a certain Henry Pence, junior, of the County aforesaid, on the 20 day of August, in the year 1811, at the house of the said Pence, in the County aforesaid, did unlawfully, & without having a licence therefor, retail & sell spirituous liquors, to wit, whiskey, rum, cider, & brandy, by the half pint & pint, to be drunk at the place where sold, to wit, at the house of the said Kiser, in the County aforesaid, contrary to the act of the General Assembly in that case made & provided, and against the peace & dignity of the Commonwealth.

This information is filed by the order of the Court, on the presentment of the grand jury.
