

Rockingham County, to wit;

Be it remembered, that on the 23^d day of September in the year 1811, Bruce ^{G.} Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth in the Superior Court of the said County, came into Court, and gave the said Court to understand and be informed, that, on the 24th day of September in the year 1809 at the parish of in the County aforesaid, it was corruptly and against the form of the Statute in such case made and provided, agreed by and between David Kyle, merchant, and Joseph Fawcett, both of the parish and County aforesaid, that the said David Kyle should lend and advance unto the said Joseph Fawcett the sum of \$3000 of lawful money of Virginia, and that the said David Kyle — should forbear and give day of payment thereof to the said Joseph Fawcett until and upon the 24th day of September in the year 1810 then next ensuing; and that the said Joseph Fawcett for the loan of the said sum of \$3000, and for giving day of payment thereof as aforesaid, should give and pay to the said David Kyle on the said 24th day of September, in the year 1810 aforesaid, then next ensuing the sum of \$360 of like lawful money; That in pursuance of the said corrupt and unlawful agreement, so made as aforesaid, the said David Kyle — afterwards, to wit, on the said 24th day of September in the year 1809 aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid, lent and advanced to the said Joseph Fawcett the said sum of \$3000; That in further pursuance of the said corrupt and unlawful agreement, the said David Kyle — afterwards, to wit, on the 24th day of September in the year 1810, at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid, took, accepted and received from the

Said Joseph Fawcett the said sum of \$ 360
for the loan of and giving day of payment
for the said sum of \$ 3000, which said sum of \$
360 so as aforesaid agreed to be given and paid to
the said David Kyle and so as aforesaid by
him taken accepted and received, exceeds the rate of
six dollars for the forbearing and giving day of pay-
ment of one hundred dollars, for one year; And so
the said attorney for the Commonwealth saith, that
the said David Kyle on the said 24th day of September
in the year 1810 aforesaid, at the parish a-
foresaid, in the County aforesaid, did unlawfully
and corruptly, by means of the aforesaid corrupt
bargain and loan take accept, and receive from
the said Joseph Fawcett for the loan and giving
day of payment, for the said first above mentioned
sum of money, above the rate of six dollars for
one hundred dollars, for one year, against the
act of Assembly in such case made and pro-
vided, and against the peace and dignity of
the Commonwealth.

And the said attorney for the Common-
wealth further gives the said court to understand
and be informed, that afterwards to wit, on the said
24th day of September in the year 1809 aforesaid,
at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid it
was further agreed by and between the said David
Kyle — and the said Joseph Fawcett
that the said David Kyle should lend and
advance unto the said Joseph Fawcett
a certain other sum of money, to wit, the sum
of \$ 3000 and that the said David Kyle —
should forbear and give day of payment

thereof until the said 24th day of September,
in the year 1810 aforesaid; That in pursuance
of the said agreement so made as aforesaid
the said ~~afterwards~~ David Kyle afterwards took,
on the said 24th day of September in the year
1809 aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid, in the County
aforesaid lent and advanced to the said
Joseph Fawcett the said sum of \$3000; And that
afterwards, to wit, on the said 24th day of September
in the year 1810 aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid,
in the County aforesaid, the said David
Kyle did unlawfully and corruptly, take accept, and receive from the said Joseph Fawcett
for the said loan and giving day of payment
for the said sum of \$3000 a certain other sum
of \$360 which said sum of \$360 so taken accept
and received, exceeds the rate of six dollars
for the forbearance and giving day of payment
of one hundred dollars, for one year against the
act of Assembly in such case made and provided,
to the evil example of all others in such case
offering, and against the peace and dignity
of the Commonwealth

And the said attorney for the Commonwealth further gives the said Court to understand
and be informed, that afterwards, to wit, on the said
24th day of September in the year 1810 aforesaid
at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid the
said David Kyle by way of corrupt bargain
did, unlawfully, and corruptly, take, accept, and receive
from the said Joseph Fawcett a certain
other sum of \$360 for the forbearing and giving

day of payment of a certain other sum of \$300⁰⁰
 which said sum of \$360 so taken accepted &
 received exceed the rate of six dollars for the for-
 bearing and giving day of payment of one hun-
 dred dollars for one year, against the act of
 Assembly in such case made and provided,
 to evil example of all others in such cases of-
 fending, and against the peace and dignity of
 the Commonwealth.
