Be it remembered, that on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September, in the year 1811, Prisco G. Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth in the Superior Court of said County, came into Court, and gave the said Court to understand, and be informed, that on the

24<sup>th</sup> day of September, in the year 1809 at the parish of \_\_\_\_\_, in the County aforesaid, it was corruptly, and against the form of the statute in such case made and provided, agreed by an between John Ewin,

yeoman, and Daniel Ragan both of the parish and County aforesaid, that the said John Ewin

should lend and advance unto the said Daniel Ragan the sum of \$ 300 of lawful money of Virginia, and that the said John Ewin should forbear and give day of payment thereof to the said Daniel Ragan until and upon the

24<sup>th</sup> day of September, in the year 1810, then next ensuing, and that the said Daniel Ragan for the loan of the said

sum of \$ 300 and for giving day of payment thereof as aforesaid, should give and pay to the said John Ewin on the said

24<sup>th</sup> day of September, in the year 1810 aforesaid, then next ensuing, the sum of \$ 21 of like lawful money; That in par-

suance of the said corrupt and unlawful a-  
greement, so made as aforesaid, the said  
John Ewin — afterwards, to wit, on the  
said 24<sup>th</sup> day of September, in the year 1809  
aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid, in the  
county aforesaid, lent and advanced to the  
said Daniel Pagan the said sum of  
\$ 300 ; That in further pursuance of  
the said corrupt and unlawful agreement,  
the said John Ewin afterwards, to wit,  
on the said 24<sup>th</sup> day of September, in the  
year 1810, at the parish aforesaid, in the  
county aforesaid, took, accepted, and received  
from the said Daniel Pagan the said sum  
of \$ 21 . for the loan of, and giving day  
of payment for, the said sum of \$ 300  
which said sum of \$ 21 , so as aforesaid a-  
greed to be given and paid to the said  
John Ewin , and so as aforesaid by him  
taken, accepted, and received, exceeds the rate  
of six dollars for the forbearing, and  
giving day of payment of one hundred dol-  
lars, for one year: And so the said attorney  
for the Commonwealth saith, that the  
said John Ewin on the said 24<sup>th</sup> day  
of September, in the year 1810 aforesaid,  
at the parish aforesaid, in the county aforesaid

said did unlawfully and corruptly, by means  
of the aforesaid corrupt bargain and loan,  
take, accept, and receive from the said  
Daniel Ragan for the loan and giving  
day of payment for the said first above men-  
tioned sum of money, above the rate of six  
dollars for one hundred dollars, for one year  
against the act of Assembly in such case  
made and provided, to the evil example  
of all others in such case offending, and  
against the peace and dignity of the Com-  
monwealth.

And the said attorney for the Com-  
monwealth further gives the said court to  
understand, as he informed, that afterwards,  
to wit, on the said 24<sup>th</sup> day of September in  
the year 1809 aforesaid, at the parish a-  
foresaid, in the County aforesaid, it was fur-  
ther agreed by and between the said John  
Ewin — and the said Daniel Ragan  
that the said John Ewin should lend  
and advance unto the said Daniel  
Ragan a certain other sum of money, to wit,  
the sum of \$300 and that the said John  
Ewin should forbear and give day  
of payment thereof until the said 24<sup>th</sup> day  
of September, in the year 1810 aforesaid;  
That in pursuance of the said agreement so  
made as aforesaid the said John Ewin

afterwards, to wit, on the said 24<sup>th</sup> day  
of September, in the year 1809 aforesaid,  
at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid,  
lent and advanced to the said Daniel Ra-  
gan the said sum of \$ 300 And that af-  
terwards, to wit, on the said 24<sup>th</sup> day of  
September, in the year 1810 aforesaid, at  
the parish aforesaid, in the County afore-  
said, the said John Ewin did unlaw-  
fully and corruptly take, accept, and re-  
ceive from the said Daniel Ragan for the  
said loan and giving day of payment for  
the said sum of \$ 300, a certain other  
sum of \$ 21, which said sum of \$ 21  
so taken, accepted, and received, exceeds  
the rate of six dollars for the forbearance  
and giving day of payment of one hundred  
dollars, for one year, against the act of  
Assembly in such case made and provided,  
to the evil example of all others, in such  
case offending, and against the peace and  
dignity of the Commonwealth.

And the said attorney for the Com-  
monwealth further gives the said Court to  
understand and be informed, that afterwards,  
to wit, on the said 24<sup>th</sup> day of September, in  
the year 1810 aforesaid, at the parish afore-  
said, in the County aforesaid, the said John  
Ewin, by way of corrupt bargain, did

unlawfully and corruptly, taken, accept,  
and receive from the said Daniel Ragau  
— a certain other sum of \$ 21 for the  
forbearing and giving day of payment of  
a certain other sum of \$ 300 which said  
sum of \$ 21, so taken, accepted, and re-  
ceived, exceeds the rate of six dollars for  
the forbearing and giving day of payment  
of one hundred dollars, for one year, a-  
gainst the act of Assembly in such case  
made and provided, to the evil example  
of all others in such case offending, and  
against the peace and dignity of the  
Commonwealth.
