

Rockingham County, to wit;

Be it remembered, that on the 23^d day of September, in the year 1811, Drusilla G. Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth in the Superior Court of said County, came into Court, and gave the said Court to understand and be informed, that on the 24.th day of September, in the year 1809, at the parish of

, in the County aforesaid, it was corruptly, and against the form of the statute in such case made and provided, agreed by and between Christian Kiger senior, yeoman and

Daniel Rager both of the parish and County aforesaid, that the said Christian Kiger senior should lend and advance unto the said

Daniel Rager — the sum of \$ 400 of lawful money of Virginia, and that the said Christian Kiger senior should forbear, and give day of payment thereof to the said

Daniel Rager — until and upon the 24.th day of September , in the year 1810,

then next ensuing; and that the said Daniel Rager for the loan of the said sum of \$ 400, and for giving day of payment thereof as aforesaid, for the time aforesaid, should give and pay to the said

Christian Kiger, senior on the said 24.th day of September in the year 1810, aforesaid, then next ensuing; the sum of \$ 200 of like lawful money; That in pursuance of the said corrupt and unlawful agreement so made

as aforesaid, the said Christian Kiger, senior after-
ward, to wit, on the said 24th day of September
in the year 1809, aforesaid, at the pa-
rish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid, lent and
advanced to the said Daniel Rager the said
sum of \$ 400; That in further pursuance of
the said corrupt and unlawful agreement,
the said Christian Kiger senior afterward, to wit, on
the 24th day of September, in the year 1810, at
the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid,
took, accepted, and received from the said
Daniel Rager the said sum of \$ 200 for
the loan of, and giving day of payment
for, the said sum of \$ 400, which said
sum of \$ 200 so as aforesaid agreed to
be given and paid to the said Christian Kiger
senior, and so as aforesaid by him taken,
accepted, and received, exceeds the rate of
six dollars for the forbearing and giving
day of payment of one hundred dollars,
for one year: And so the said attorney for
the Commonwealth saith, that the said
Christian Kiger senior on the said 24th day of
September, in the year 1810, aforesaid, at
the parish aforesaid, in the County afore-
said, did unlawfully and corruptly, by means
of the aforesaid corrupt bargain and loan,
take, accept, and receive from the said
Daniel Rager for the loan of, and giving
day of payment for the said first above
mentioned sum of money, above the rate

of six dollars for one hundred dollars,
for one year, against the act of Assembly in
such case made and provided, to the end
example of all others in such case offe-
ding, and against the peace and dignity
of the Commonwealth.

And the said attorney for the Com-
monwealth further gives the said Court to
understand, and be informed, that after-
wards, to wit, on the said 24th day of Sep-
tember, in the year 1809 aforesaid, at
the parish aforesaid, in the County afores-
aid, it was further agreed by and between the
said Christian Kiger, senior, and the said Daniel
Rager, that the said Christian Kiger, senior
should lend and advance unto the said
Daniel Rager, a certain other sum of
money, to wit, the sum of \$ 400, and that the
said Christian Kiger senior should forbear and
give day of payment thereof until the said
24th day of September, in the year 1810
aforesaid; That in pursuance of the said
agreement made as aforesaid, the said
Christian Kiger, senior afterwards, to wit, on
the said 24th day of September, in the year
1809 aforesaid lent and advanced to the
said Daniel Rager the said sum of \$
400; And that afterward, to wit, on the said
24th day of September in the year 1810, afo-
resaid, the said Christian Kiger, senior did unlaw-

fully take, accept, and receive from the said Daniel Rogers for the said loan and, giving day of payment for the said sum of \$ 400 a certain other sum of \$ 200 which said sum of \$ 200, so taken, accepted, and received, exceeds the rate of six dollars for the forbearance, and giving day of payment of one hundred dollars, for one year, against the act of Assembly in such case made and provided, to the evil example of all others in such case offending, and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth.

And the said attorney for the Commonwealth further gives the said Court to understand and be informed, that afterward, to wit, on the said 24th day of September, in the year 1710 aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid the said Christian Higginson by way of corrupt bargain, did unlawfully and corruptly take, accept, and receive from the said Daniel Rogers a certain other sum of \$ 200 for the forbearing and giving day of payment of a certain other sum of \$ 400 which said sum of \$ 200, so taken, accepted, and received, exceeds the rate of six dollars for the forbearing and giving day of payment of one hundred dollars, for one year, against the act of Assembly in such case made and provided, to the evil

example of all others in such case offend-
ing, and against the peace and dignity of
the Commonwealth.
