Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting for the commonwealth in the Superior Court of said County, came into Court, and gave the said Court to understand and be informed, that, on the 24th day of September, in the year 1809, at the parish of _____, in the County aforesaid, it was corruptly, and against the form of the statute in such case made and provided, agreed by and between George Kiger, farmer and Daniel Ragen, both of the parish and County aforesaid, that the said George Kiger should lend and advance unto the said Daniel Ragen the sum of \$ 400 of lawful money of Virginia, and that the said George Kiger should forbear, and give day of payment thereof to the said Daniel Ragen until and upon the 24th day of September, in the year 1810, then next ensuing, and that the said Daniel Ragen for the loan of the said sum of \$ 400, and for giving day of payment thereof as aforesaid, for the time aforesaid, should give and pay to the said George Kiger, on the said 24th day of September, in the year 1810, aforesaid, then next ensuing, the sum of \$ 200 of like

lawful money; That in pursuance of the said
corrupt and unlawful agreement, so made as
aforesaid, the said George Kizer after-
wards, to wit, on the said 24th day of September,
in the year ¹⁸⁰⁹ aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid,
in the county aforesaid, ~~did corruptly and~~

sum of \$ 400; That in further pursuance of
the said corrupt and unlawful agreement, the
said George Kizer afterward, to wit, on the
24th day of September, in the year 1810, at the

accepted, and received from the said Daniel
Ragen the said sum of \$ 200, for the loan of
and giving day of payment for the said sum
of \$ 400, which said sum of \$ 200, so as aforesaid
agreed to be given and paid to the said

taken, accepted, and received, exceeds the rate
of six dollars for the forbearing, and giving
day of payment of one hundred dollars, for
one year; And so the said attorney for the

for the loan, and giving day of payment for the said first above mentioned sum of money, above the rate of six dollars for one hundred dollars, for one year, against the act of Assembly in such case made and provided, to the evil example of all others in such case offending, and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth.

And the said attorney for the Commonwealth further gives the said court to understand, and be informed, that afterwards, to wit, on the said 24th day of September, in the year 1809 aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid, it was ~~further~~ agreed by and between the said George Kizer and the said Daniel Ragen, that the said George Kizer should lend and advance unto the said Daniel Ragen a certain other sum of money, to wit, the sum of \$ 400, and that the said George Kizer should forbear and give day of payment thereof until the said 24th day of September, in the year 1810, aforesaid; That in pursuance of the said agreement so made as aforesaid, the said George Kizer afterwards, to wit, on the said 24th day of September, in the year 1809 aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid, lent and advanced to the said Daniel Ragen the said sum of \$ 400; And that afterwards, to wit
