

Rockingham County, to wit;

Be it remembered, that on the 23^d day of September
of in the year 1811, Briscoe & Baldwin the attorney prosecuting for
the Commonwealth in the Superior Court of said County, came into
court, and gave the said Court to understand and be informed, that
on the 24th day of September in the year 1809 at the parish
of _____ in the County aforesaid it was corruptly and against
the form of the Statute in such case made and provided, agreed
by and between David Kyle, merchant, — and
Daniel Ragen both of the parish and County aforesaid that the
said David Kyle should lend and advance unto the said
Daniel Ragen ^{for the use of Samuel M^r. Williams} the sum of \$ 200 of lawful money of Virginia
and that the said David Kyle should forbear and
give day of payment thereof to the said Daniel Ragen
until and upon the 24th day of September in the year 1810
then next ensuing, and that the said Daniel Ragen for
the loan of the said sum of \$ 200 and for giving day of
payment thereof as aforesaid for the time aforesaid, should give and
pay to the said David Kyle on the said 24th day of
September in the year 1810 aforesaid, then next ensuing the
sum of \$ 100 of like lawful money; That in pursuance of
the said corrupt and unlawful agreement so made as aforesaid the
said David Kyle afterwards, to wit, on the said 24th
day of September in the year 1809 aforesaid, at the parish
aforesaid, in the County aforesaid, lent and advanced to the said
Daniel Ragen the said sum of \$ 200; That in

further pursuance of the said corrupt and unlawful agreement
the said David Kyle afterwards, to wit on the 24th
day of September in the year 1810 at the parish aforesaid
in the County aforesaid, took, accepted, and received from the said
Daniel Rager the said sum of \$ 100 for the loan of, and giving
day of payment for the said sum of \$ 200 which said sum of
\$ 100 so as aforesaid agreed to be given and paid to the said
David Kyle and so as aforesaid by him taken, accepted, and
received, exceed the rate of six dollars for the forbearing and giving
day of payment of one hundred dollars, for one year: And so
the said attorney for the Commonwealth saith that the said
David Kyle, — on the said 24th day of September in the
year 1810 aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid in the County,
aforesaid, did unlawfully and corruptly, by means of the aforesaid
corrupt bargain and loan, take accept. and receive from the said
Daniel Rager for the loan of and giving day of payment
for the said first above mentioned sum of money above the
rate of six dollars for one hundred dollars for one year, against
the act of assembly in such case made and provided, to the evil
example of all others in such case offending, and against the peace
and dignity of the Commonwealth — And the said attorney
for the Commonwealth further gives the said Court to understand
and be informed, that afterwards to wit on the said 24th day of
September, in the year 1809 aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid
in the County aforesaid, it was further agreed by and between
the said David Kyle — and the said Daniel
Rager that the said David Kyle should lend

and advance unto the said Daniel Rager a certain
other sum of money, to wit, The sum of \$ 200 and that the said
David Kyle should forbear and give day of payment
therefor until the said 24th day of September, in the year
1810 aforesaid, that in pursuance of the said agreement so made
as aforesaid, the said David Kyle afterwards, to wit, on
the said 24th day of September in the year 1809
aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid, lent and
advanced to the said Daniel Rager the said sum of \$ 200
and that afterwards, to wit, on the said 24th day of September, in
the year 1810 aforesaid at the parish aforesaid in the County
aforesaid, the said David Kyle did unlawfully and
corruptly take, accept, and receive from the said Daniel Rager,
for the said loan of, and giving day of payment for, the said sum of
\$ 200, a certain other sum of \$ 100 which said sum of \$ 100
so taken, accepted, and received, exceeds the rate of six dollars for the
forbearing and giving day of payment of one hundred dollars, for
one year, against the act of assembly in such case made and provided
to the evil example of all others in such case offending, and against
the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth.

And the said attorney for the Commonwealth further gives the
said Court to understand, and be informed, that afterwards to wit
on the said 24th day of September in the year 1810
aforesaid, at the parish aforesaid, in the County aforesaid the
said David Kyle — by way of corrupt bargain did
unlawfully and corruptly take accept, and receive from the

Said Daniel Ragen a certain other sum of \$ 100
for the forbearing and giving day, of payment of a certain other
sum of \$ 200 which said sum of \$ 100 so taken, accepted
and received, exceeds the rate of six dollars for the forbearing and
giving day, of payment of one hundred dollars, for one year, against
the act of assembly, in such case made and provided, to the
evil example of all others in such case offending, and against
the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth.
