Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth in the Superior Court of the County aforesaid, came into court, & gave the said Court to understand & be informed, that, on the 20th day of October, in the year 1810, in the County aforesaid, before Aher Waterman, ^{then} a Justice of the peace for the said County, one Gordon Rodgers _____ of the said County, had impleaded one John Smith Shoemaker of the same County, in a Pleas that he should render to him the sum of \$10, which he owed him & unjustly detained, of which said Pleas the said Aher Waterman then & there had jurisdiction, by the laws of this Commonwealth, to try & determine. And whereas the said John Smith then moved the said Justice to for a continuance of the said Pleas. And further the said Briscoe G. Baldwin gave the said Court to understand & be informed, that whilst the said motion for a continuance was depending, to wit, on the said 20th day of October, in the year 1810, in the county aforesaid, before the said Justice, the said John Smith was then & there sworn on the Holy Evangelists ^{by the said Justice,} to say the truth, the whole truth, & nothing but the truth, ~~of his coming before~~ the said motion then & there depending before the said Justice, who was then a person duly authorized to administer the said oath, and that

the same John Smith, not having God before his eyes, but being moved and seduced by the instigation of the devil, then & there by his own proper act & consent falsely & maliciously, voluntarily & corruptly on his oath aforesaid said, deposed, swore, and to the Justice aforesaid on the said motion in evidence gave, that he could not go into the trial because he had material witness absent whose attendance he could not have
