lor late of <sup>the parish of</sup> in the County aforesaid, saddler  
did on the third day of November, in the year of  
our Lord 1811 with force & arms in the County  
aforesaid, & within the jurisdiction of the Circuit  
Court aforesaid one pair of saddle bags made  
of leather of the value of five dollars, seven bridle  
bits made of iron <sup>& silver</sup> of the value of twenty three dollars, five  
pair of stirrup irons made of iron & silver of the value of  
twenty dollars, six pair of martingale hooks made of iron &  
silver of the value of four dollars & fifty cents, four cast chains  
of the goods & chattels of one Joshua Peters then  
& there being found feloniously did steal, take  
against the act of the General Assembly in that case made & provided  
& carry away, & against the peace & dignity  
of the Commonwealth.
