Be it remembered that on the 5th day of
August 1812 in the ~~same~~ County aforesaid,
Jonathan Burnside (labouring Solomon—
Name yeoman, and Richard Harrod yeoman
of the same place came before Me one of
the Common withs, justices of the peace
for the County aforesaid and acknowledged
their Selves to owe to James Barbours Esqr
Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Common-
wealth of Virginia and his successors to
wit, the said Jonathan Burnside the sum
of one hundred dollars, and the said Solomon
and the sum of fifty dollars, and Richard
Harrod the sum of fifty dollars, current
money of Virginia to be ~~respectfully~~ respectfully
pay, levied and made, of their several goods and
chattels lands and tenements to the use of
the Common with aforesaid, if he the said
Jonathan Burnside shall fail in perform-
ing the conditions under written—

The conditions of this recognizance is
such, that if the above bound Jonathan
Burnside shall personally appear at
the next Court to be holden in and for
the County of Buckingham, to do
what shall then and there be enjoined
him by the sd Court, and in the mean
time ~~shall keep the peace and be of the good be-
haviour~~ ~~shall keep the peace~~ shall keep the peace

and be of good behaviour towards ~~all~~ the
Commonwealth and all its Citizens and
especially ~~against~~ towards Delila Burnside
of the said County then the said Recogniza-
