Memorandum that upon the 18th February 1812
James Fulton Babour of said Henry Smith
of said County James personally appeared before
me Andrew Shanklin a Justice of the peace
for the County aforesaid and acknowledged
that they do owe James Barbour Governor
or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth
of Virginia and his Successors to wit, the said
James Fulton the sum of one hundred
and ~~forty~~ ^{thirty} dollars and the said Henry Smith
in the sum of seventy dollars of lawfull
money of Virginia to be levied on their
~~respective~~ respective goods and chattels lands
and tenements to the use of the said Commonwealth
of Virginia if default should be made in payment
of the Comptition hereunder written

The condition of this Recognizance is
that whereas ~~James~~ ~~James~~ Peggy Lane
of the County of Augusta a Single Woman
hath by her Examination on oath before
Alexander Robertson of the said County of
Augusta declared that on the 1st day
of December last past that she was seized
of a Bastard Child in the said County

of a Fugitive Slave the which is likely
to be borne chargeable the said County
and Home charged the above named James
Tutton of having begotten him with child
of the said Bastard child

Now if the said James
Tutton shall personally appear
before the next month's Justices of the
peace at the next Court held for the
County of Buckingham and shall abide
by and perform the order or orders of such
Court as shall be made in the premises

then the foregoing to be void otherwise

Whereas Peggy Lamb of the county of Augusta single woman
hath by her Examination taken in writing on oath before Alip and
Robertson one of the ^{commonwealths} justices of the peace for the county aforesaid declared
that on the twenty sixth Day of December, 1841 in the county aforesaid
the said Peggy Lamb was delivered of a female Bastard child and
that the said Bastard child is likely to become chargeable to the
County and hath charged James Fulton of Buckingham County
of having gotten her with child of the said Bastard child and whereas
James Bell one of the overseers of the poor in the county of Augusta
aforesaid in order to indemnify the said county in the premises
hath applied to me to issue my warrant for apprehending the
said James Fulton I do therefore command you immediately
to apprehend the said James Fulton and to bring him before me
at some other justice of the peace for said county of Buckingham
to find ^{sufficient} security ~~sum~~ in amount not less than fifty nor more than
two hundred Dollars for his personal appearance at the next court
to be held for the said county of Buckingham and then and there to abide
by and perform the orders of the said court herein in pursuance of
the act for ^{the} better regulation of the general assembly entitled an act
Providing for the poor and Declaring who shall be deemed
vagrants ^{and} under my hand and seal this 17th day of
February 1842
