in the parish of & county aforesaid, & within the
jurisdiction of the said Court did unlawfully
& without having a license therefor retail &
sell spirituous liquors, to wit, wine, whiskey,
cyder, rum, beer & brandy & mixtures thereof
by the half pint & pint, to be drunk at
the place where sold to wit at the meet-
ing place near the dwelling house of said George Perry
in the parish & county aforesaid, & within
the jurisdiction of the said Court against
the act of the General Assembly in that
case made & provided, & against the peace
& dignity of the Commonwealth.
