Be it remembered that on the 26th day of April, in the year 1813, Bricey G. Baldwin the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth in the Circuit Court of said County, came into Court, & gave the said Court to understand & be informed, that a certain Adam Hembarger, parson of the parish of Rockingham in the County aforesaid, on the 1st day of September in the year 1812, at the house of said Hembarger in the parish & County aforesaid, & within the jurisdiction of the said Court, did unlawfully & without having a license therefor, retail & sell spirituous liquors, to wit Whiskey, wine, beer &c &c own & brandy & mixtures thereof, by the half pint & pint, to be drunk at the place where sold, to wit, at the house of said Hembarger, in the parish & County aforesaid, contrary to the act of the General Assembly in that case made & provided, & against the peace & dignity of the Commonwealth.

This information is filed by order of the Court, on the presentment of the grand jury.
