Be it remembered that on the 26.th day of
April, in the year 1813, Orison G. Baldwin
the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth
in the Circuit Court of said County, came
into Court, & gave the said Court to under-
stand & be informed, that a certain Adam
Hansberger, farmer of the parish of Rock-
ingham in the County aforesaid, on the 1.st
day of September in the year 1811, at the
house of said Hansberger in the parish &
County aforesaid, & within the Jurisdiction
of the said Court, did unlawfully & without
having a license therefor, retail & sell
spirited liquors, to wit, Whiskey, wine,
beer, sugar rum, & brandy & mixtures there-
of, by the half pint & pint, to be drunk
at the place where sold, to wit, at the
house of said Hansberger, in the parish
& County aforesaid, contrary to the act of
the General Assembly in that case made
& provided, & against the peace & dignity
of the Commonwealth.

This information is filed by order
of the Court, on the presentment
of the grand jury.
