day of April, in the year 1813, Orison
G. Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting
for the Commonwealth in the Circuit
Court of said County came into Court
& gave the said Court to understand
& be informed, that, ^{a certain} Nathaniel Britton
spirited, of the parish of Rockingham
in the County aforesaid, on the 1st
day of September in the year 1811 at
the house of said Britton in
the parish & county aforesaid, & within
the jurisdiction of the said Court,
did unlawfully & without having
a license therefor, retail & sell
spiruous liquors, to wit, whiskey, wine,
beer, cyder, rum, & brandy, & mixtures
thereof, by the pint & half pint, to be
drank at the place where sold, to wit, at
the house of the said Britton in the
parish & county aforesaid, contrary to
the act of the General Assembly in
that case made & provided, & against the
peace & dignity of the Commonwealth.

This information is filed by order
of the Court, & the prosecution of the
