upon their oath present that at a Superior Court of Law begun and held for Rockingham County at the Courthouse of ^{the} County of Rockingham on Friday the 1st of May 1812 a certain issue (duly joined in said Court holden for the County of Rockingham between a certain Henry Bear plaintiff and a certain George Outy Defendant on a certain action of Tress then & there instituted by the ^{said} Henry Bear against the ^{said} George Outy to recover in damages the value of a certain Pick of Hemp belonging to the ^{said} Henry Bear and which had come to the possession of the ^{said} George Outy) came on to be tried in due form of law and was then and there tried by a certain jury of the County of Rockingham in that behalf duly sworn and taken between the ^{said} Henry Bear and the said George Outy. And the jurors aforesaid upon their oath ^{present} ^{as further} that on the trial of the said issue so joined as aforesaid David Long late of the Parish of in the said County of Rockingham Farmer appeared as a witness for and on behalf of the said George Outy and was sworn and then and there took his corporal oath upon the Holy Gospel of God before the Court holden for the County of Rockingham aforesaid to speak the truth the whole truth and nothing but the truth touching and concerning the matters in question in the said issue.
