Solomon Bowers shall fail in perform^{ing} the
Conditions under written

The Conditions of this recognizance is such that if the
above bound Solomon Bowers shall personally appear
at the next Court to be holden in and for the County
Aforesaid to see and receive what shall then and there
be enjoined him by the said Court and in the mean
time shall keep the peace and be of good behavior
towards the Commonwealth and all its Citizens and Espec-
=ially towards John Loker of Rockingham in the said County
yeoman then the said Recognizance to be void or else
remain in full force
