You are hereby com

manded to receive the body of James Boswell a free man
of colour who is charged before me a justice of the peace
in & for the County of a felony in being accessory with
Jann a negro slave who is charged with a felony in
feloniously taking ^{money} of the value of twenty five dollars out
of the desk of a certain Denis Senekhan in the county
of Rockingham and the sd James Boswell you are hereby
commanded safely to keep until he shall be discharged
by due course of law and this shall be your lawful
warrant for the same given under my hand this ^{29 day} day

November 1813
