of September, in the year 1812, at the
parish of _____ in the County afore-
said, & within the jurisdiction of the
said Court, Abraham Rader late of the
parish & County aforesaid labourer with
force & arms did unlawfully fight with
one Richard Carrier & him the said Rich-
ard Carrier & then & there assaulting &
him the said Richard Carrier & then & there
beating, wounding, & ill-treating - so that
his life was greatly imperiled of & other
wrongs to the said Richard Carrier - then &
there did to the great damage of the said
Richard Carrier & against the peace
& dignity of the Commonwealth -
