Be it remembered, that on the 25th day of
April, in the year of our Lord 1814 Briscoe &
Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting for the
Commonwealth in the Superior Court of the
Said County came into Court, & gave the
Said Court to understand & be informed that
Richard Carrier late of the parish of
& County aforesaid farmer heretofore
to wit on the 20th day of September in
the year 1812 at the parish & County aforesaid
And within the jurisdiction of the Said
Court with force & arms did unlawfully fight
with one Abraham Rader & him the said
Abraham Rader did then & there assault
Beat, Wound, & ill Treat, so that his life
was greatly endangered, & other wrongs to
him the said Abraham Rader then and
there did, to the great damage of him the
said Abraham Rader & against the peace
& dignity of the Commonwealth
