Baldwin, the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth in the Superior Court of the said County, came into Court, & gave the said Court to understand & be informed, that a certain Christopher Loomer, ^{dwelling the place} farmer, of the County aforesaid, on the day of in the year at the house of the said Loomer in the County aforesaid, ^{& within the jurisdiction of said court}, did unlawfully, & without having a license therfor, retail & sell spirituous liquors, to wit, ^{whiskey}, wine, beer, ciders, rum, brandy, & mixtures thereof, by the pint & half pint, to be drunk at the place where sold, to wit, at the house of the said Loomer, in the County aforesaid, contrary to the act of the General Assembly in that case made & provided, & against the peace & dignity of the Commonwealth.

This information is filed by the orders of the Court, on the presentment of the grand jury.
