Baldwin, the Attorney prosecuting for the
Commonwealth in the Superior Court of the
Said County came into Court & gave the said

Rice late of the parish of

County aforesaid Labourer heretofore, to wit
on the 20.th day of September in the year
1812 at the parish & County aforesaid &
within the Jurisdiction of the Said Court
with force & arms did unlawfully fight
with one Abraham Joseph then the said
~~same~~ Joseph did then & there assault
beat, wound, & ill treat, so that his life was
greatly imperiled, & other wrongs to him the
Said ~~same~~ Joseph then & there did,
to the great damage of him the said Joseph
~~same~~ Against the peace & dignity
of the Commonwealth.
