The Jurors of the Commonwealth of & for the
body of the County aforesaid do on their oath
present that George Barr Farmer late of the
parish of Rockingham & County aforesaid
heretofore, to wit. on the 30th
day of August in the year 1814

at the parish & County aforesaid and within
the jurisdiction of the said Court with force &
arms in and upon one Jacob Hoover in the
peace of God and the Commonwealth then and
there being did make an assault & him the
said Jacob Hoover then & there did beat
wound and ill treat so that his life was greatly
endangered of & other wrongs to ^{him} the said Jacob
Hoover then and there did, to
the great damage of ^{him} the said Jacob Hoover
and against the peace and
dignity of the Commonwealth.
