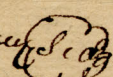

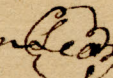

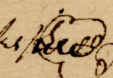
Be it remembered that on the 18th day of April 1815, George Rumsey and Thomas Dean, and also William Mankshire and Joshua Tate came before me Joseph Cravens one of the Commonwealths Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid and acknowledged themselves to owe to Wilson Cary ~~Esquire~~ Nicholas esquire Governor or chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia and his Successors to wit the Said George Rumsey the Sum of fifty Dollars and the Said Thomas Dean the Sum of fifty Dollars, and also William Mankshire Joshua Tate the Sum of fifty Dollars each to be respectue levied and made of their goods & Chattels, lands and tenements to the use of the Commonwealth aforesaid, if the Said George Rumsey, & William Mankshire shall fail in performing the Condition underwritten

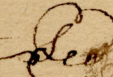
The Condition of the above ~~obligation~~ Recognizance is such that if the above bound George Rumsey & William Mankshire shall personally appear at the next court to be holden in and for the County ~~aforesaid~~ of Rockingham aforesaid to do and receive what shall then and there be enjoined them by the Said Court and in the mean time shall keep the peace towards the Commonwealth and all its Citizens and especially towards Valentine Bottom, Then the Said recognizance shall be void or else remain in full force - In witness whereof the parties have herunto subscribed their hands & affixed their Seals this 18th day of April 1815
