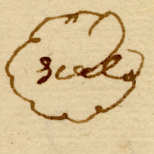


Rockingham Ct. to wit. Whereas Henry Mace of Rocking-
ham Ct. Black Smith, hath personally come before me Benj-
Lewis a Justice of the peace for the Ct aforesaid, & hath taken a
Corporal Oath, that he the said Henry Mace is affraid Joel
Taylor & Polly Swaney Both of Rockingham Ct. will beat
or do him some bodily hurt, & hath therefore prayed security
of the peace against, them the said Joel Taylor & Polly
Swaney: There are therefore in the name of the common-
wealth to command you, that immediately upon the
receipt hereof you bring the said Joel Taylor & Polly Swaney
before me, to find security, as well for their personal ap-
pearance at the next court to be holden for the said Ct
as also for their keeping the peace in the mean time, to-
wards the Citizens of this commonwealth, & chiefly towards
the said Henry Mace. Given under my hand &
seal this 20th June 1815

Rockingham Ct. to wote. Be it remembered, that on the 22 of June
in the year of our Lord 1815 Joel Taylor of the County of Rockingham
Labourer & Polly Swaney of the same County & George Lemmons
of the same Ct. Labourer, came before me one of the commonwealths
Justices of the ^{peace} for the County aforesaid & acknowledged themselves to owe
to Wilson C. Nicholas esquire, governor or chief Magistrate of the common
wealth of Virginia, & his successors, to wit the said Joel Taylor the sum of
one hundred Dollars & the said Polly Swaney the sum of one hundred
Dollars & said George Lemmons the sum of one hundred Dollars, current
money of Virginia, to be respectively levied & made of their several goods
& Chattles, Lands & tenements, to the use of the commonwealth aforesaid,
if they the said Joel Taylor & Polly Swaney, shall fail in performing
the conditions underwritten.

The Condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above
sacred Joel Taylor & Polly Swaney shall personally appear at the next
Court to be holden in & for the County of Rockingham aforesaid, to do &
receive what shall then & there be enjoined on them by the said Court
& in the mean time shall keep the peace & be of good behaviour to wote,
the commonwealth & all its Citizens & especially to wote Henry Mace
in the said County of Rockingham Blacksmith: then the above
obligation to be void, or else remain in full force
