and in the name of the Commonwealth to command
you jointly and severally that immediately upon the receipt
hereof you bring the said Nancy Cummins before me
to find surety as well for her personal appearance at the
next Court to be holden for the said County as also for
her keeping the peace in the mean time towards the
Citizens of this Commonwealth and chiefly towards
the said Margret Cummins given under my hand
and seal at ^{from} rockingham the said County the 25 day
of october in the year — 1816

before me Thomas Moore one of the Commonwealths
Justice of the peace for the Said County and Acknowledged
themselves to owe William W. Nicholas Esquire Governor
or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia
and his Successors to wit the Said Nancy Cummins in the
Sum of one Hundred Dollars Lawful money the Said Moses
Cummins in the Sum of one Hundred Dollars and Noah
Higgs in the Sum of one Hundred Dollars Lawful money
Who be respectively Seized of their several Goods and
Chattels lands and tenements to the use of the Commonwealth
of Virginia if the the aforesaid Nancy Cummins
shall fail in performing the Condition underwritten

The Condition of this Recognizance is Such that if the
above bound Nancy Cummins shall personal Appear
at the next Court to be holden in and for the Said
County of Rockingham Aforesaid to do and receive what shall
then and there be Injoined her by the Said Court and
in the mean time shall keep the peace and be of good
behavior or shall keep the peace and be of good behavior
towards the Commonwealth and all its Citizens and
Especially towards Peggy Cummins of Rockingham
then the Above Recognizance to be void or else to remain
in full force
