Therefore on behalf of the Commonwealth I require you to summon (at least Eight of the Justices of the peace of the said County) to meet at the Court house of the said County on Monday the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December next, then and there to hold a court for the examination of the facts with which the said Abraham Meriwanger alias Mester Miller stands charged, (which Court is to consist of at least five of the said Justices) and for such other purposes concerning the premises as is by Law required and directed, and that you have this then Warrant given under my hand and seal this 25<sup>th</sup> November 1815
